Meeting was informal, general introductions around the room to support parents who attended ECT gathering for first time.

Discussion on recent survey sent out to all Emmaus community relating to purpose, name and meeting format/time/date

- Families continue to want a sense of belonging within the school community
- COVID resulted in dis-connection due to emphasis on social distancing;
 - some families only know each other due to kinder
 - some kids have become more independent as they needed to walk themselves in, so parents didn't gather like kinder
- Discussion on
 - "It takes a village to raise a child'; if parents have strong connections that will show/champion this to their children
 - Important that we celebrate the good work and culture at Emmaus, that we are not broken; we simply need to keep things innovative, fun and engaging across a variety of efforts.

More activities like Art exhibition, Buskers/concerts; families connect gently with a distraction. Informal feel support parents who may have social anxiety	Engagement, insight to school life

Regular social gathering at nights – Like Friday night sport nights held earlier this year. Potentially another family picnic. If numbers are an issue, split in Emmaus sport grouping, or A-L, M-Z- etc	Engagement
Support out of school extra curriculums activities ; Netball, futsal teams. Kids & parents build strong relationships due to frequent gatherings, point of interest	Engagement, marketing to broader community
