## Measurement

Our focus in Numeracy will begin with 'Measurement'.

### Year 1 student goals:

I can ...

\* compare objects accurately using uniform, informal units. (The unit of measurement must be the same size, starting same starting point, no gaps)

\* use the language, heavier, lighter, same to describe and compare the mass of objects.

\* measure the capacity of containers using uniform material.

\* describe using language of full, half full, empty to make comparison of capacity.

### Year 2 student goals:

I can...

\* describe the length of the object using informal units

\* describe the area of the object using informal units

\* describe the capacity of the object using informal units

## Writing:

In Literacy our writing focus will begin with a recount of holiday events/experiences.

### Year 1 student goals....

\* I can use capital letters and full stops in my writing most of the time.

\* I can experiment with different punctuation, including question marks and exclamation marks

### Year 2 student goal...

\* I can reread and edit my writing, checking my work for appropriate vocabulary, structure and meaning.
